OTOLARYNGOLOGISTS

Otolaryngologists, (*oh•toe•lair•in•goll•oh•gists*) more commonly known as Ear, Nose, Throat, Head and Neck Surgeons, specialize in the diagnosis, treatment and surgery of disorders of the ear, nose, throat, head and neck areas. Otolaryngologists also treat and manage many primary care problems in both children and adults.

Otolaryngologists are different from other specialists because they are trained in both medicine and surgery. As a patient, you will not need to be referred to another physician when surgery is needed. The most appropriate care, medically and surgically, can be provided for each individual patient.

What Do Otolaryngologists Treat?

EARS—Diseases of the ear, ear infections, hearing and balance disorders, ear noise (tinnitus), nerve disorders, cancer, traumatic injury, hearing loss and management of outer and inner ear congenital (birth) disorders.

NOSE—Management and care of the nasal cavity and sinuses, including treatment of snoring and breathing problems, evaluation and treatment for allergies.

THROAT—Tonsil and adenoid infection, airway problems, diseases of the larynx (voice box), hoarseness and swallowing disorders.

FACIAL PLASTIC AND RECONSTRUCTIVE SURGERY—Cosmetic and reconstructive surgery of the head and neck.

HEAD AND NECK—Management of infectious diseases, facial trauma, deformities and benign and malignant (cancerous) tumors of the face and neck including the thyroid.

APPOINTMENTS

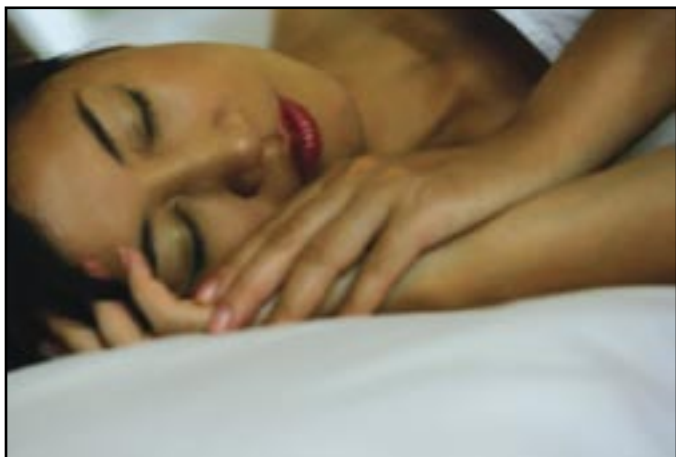
When you call our office to make an appointment with one of our physicians, we will do our very best to schedule a time that is convenient for you. When you schedule your appointment, you will be asked to describe the nature of your problem so the appropriate time can be scheduled. Our office hours are 9-5 Monday through Friday.

When you come for your appointment, please be sure to bring the following items with you:

- Current list of medications
- Your insurance cards
- X-rays performed at another facility if related to current problem

If you are unable to keep your appointment, please notify the office as soon as possible. This courtesy will allow us to provide care for another patient.

If you are a new patient to our specialty, please come prepared to complete paperwork for your medical record.



SLEEP CENTER

Approximately 18 million Americans need help in achieving a good night's sleep. Our Sleep Center is a state-of-the-art facility featuring the most recent technology for diagnosing a variety of sleep disorders. Our two bed sleep center offers a home-like setting for a comfortable experience.

OBSTRUCTIVE SLEEP APNEA

Our physicians are trained in the special procedures for diagnosing and treating sleep problems, the most common of which is Obstructive Sleep Apnea. This is a condition that occurs when a person stops breathing during sleep, often causing multiple periods of waking that the sleeper may not even remember. This can result in daily fatigue and increased risk for high blood pressure, heart disease, and stroke.

Fortunately, our Sleep Center can offer effective treatments for Obstructive Sleep Apnea.

PRESCRIPTION REFILLS

For prescription refills on medicine prescribed by any of the ENT physicians, please call our office during the hours of 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday at 910-215-2652. To ensure a same-day response, please call before 1 p.m. You will reach a recorded message, but messages are monitored all day. Your call will be returned as soon as possible. Please note that after office hours and on weekends or holidays, the doctor on call does not have access to your personal records and will be unable to refill your prescription.

PAYMENT

Payment is expected at the time services are provided. For your convenience, we accept cash, personal checks, MasterCard, VISA, Discover, and American Express. We will also file your insurance at no charge.

It is important to know that you are ultimately responsible for payment of your bill. We suggest you keep copies of all billing information should you need to follow up on claims with your insurance company. Our staff members will be glad to review this information with you and answer any questions.
